Sterling Napa Cabernet Sauvignon

Dark ruby color opens to spicy notes of raspberry and black cherry; hints of cedar and toasty oak round out the aroma. Black cherry, blackberry, raspberries, hints of roasted coffee and an earthy savory spiciness coat the palate, leading to a long, elegant finish ~ \$46

La Crema Monterey Chardonnay

Bursts of vivid citrus and fresh green apple aromas, laced with subtle notes of honeysuckle and clove. On the palate, flavors broaden into rich spiced apple and crisp lime zest with vanilla and caramel tones adding richness and texture on the finish ~ \$34

Chateau Ste. Michelle Indian Wells Vineyard Merlot

Ripe berry fruit aromas and jammy flavors typical of Wahluke Slope reds. This is a full bodied style of warm-climate Merlot with a round, supple finish ~ \$30

Red Door Cellars Willamette Pinot Noir

Layered aromas of cigar box and wild cherry marry with earthy notes. A structured palate continues with cherry and cranberry enveloped by developed oak characters. A beautifully balanced finish leaves lingering fruit and oak notes ~ \$30

Murphy Goode Merlot

Bright acidity balances jammy fruit flavors, making this merlot highly food friendly. Oak barrel aging adds toasty aromas of sweet smoke, toffee and cedar ~ \$28

Eola Hills Pinot Noir

Packed with dark cherries, black pepper and spice and a subtle touch of licorice ~ \$26

Jekel Cabernet Sauvignon

Aromas of plum, blackberry, black cherry and currants rise from the glass and mingle with notes of coffee bean and toasted oak ~ \$22

337 Lodi Cabernet Sauvignon

Blackberry and cassis, chocolate and a little vanilla à la crème brûlée aromas are complemented by oak flavors in this medium-bodied wine ~ \$23

Renwood Red Zinfandel

Bouquet of cranberry, allspice, nutmeg and blackberry compote ~ \$27

Banfi Chianti Classico

Alluring bouquet of black fruit and violets with rich flavors of cherry, supple tannins and good acidity for dining ~ \$26

Meridian Chardonnay

Notes of fresh cut flowers, lychee, vanilla, nutmeg and a dash of toasted almond ~ \$18

Saddlerock Chardonnay

Pale straw color with aromas of green apple, citrus and hint of oak. Tropical Fruit flavors like melon and pineapple and a dash of vanilla caress your mouth. Light butterscotch overtones blend delicately with acidity creating character and depth ~ \$18

Sartori Pinot Grigio

Medium-bodied with pear, spice and floral notes with a crispness ~ \$18

Salneval Albariño

Light straw in color, the nose of this Albariño is seductive with honey, pear and tropical fruit and a slight mineral component; racy and zesty with citrus and floral flavors ~ \$20

Chateau Ste. Michelle Riesling

Juicy peach, ripe pear and melon finished with subtle mineral notes ~ \$18

Copperidge Cabernet Sauvignon

Ruby-hued intense young, bright wine. Aromas of blueberry, red cherry and raspberry are accented by darker notes of coffee bean, spicy bramble and hints of caramel ~ \$4.95

Sycamore Lane Merlot

Aromas are somewhat exotic, melding spicy with dark cherry and blackberry notes highlighted by hints of violet and lavender ~ \$4.95

Banfi Chianti Classico

Alluring bouquet of black fruit and violets, rich cherry flavor with good acidity ~ \$5.95

Sycamore Lane Pinot Grigio

Aromas of Asian pear, honeydew and citrus blossom, overtly fruity yet complex ~ \$4.95

Sycamore Lane Chardonnay

Mouth-filling and juicy, with intense ripe fruit character and tropical nuances ~ \$4.95

Copperidge White Zinfandel

Fresh red berry, citrus and melon aromas with flavors of nutmeg and cloves ~ \$4.95

Casillero del Diablo Reserva Sauvignon Blanc

Straw color with green hues. Fresh aromas with hints of citrus, peaches and gooseberry, balanced with attractive, crisp acidity ~ \$4.95
