FRUIT TORTE

Cream 1 cup sugar and 1/2 cup butter. Add 1 cup sifted flour
1 teaspoon baking powder
2 eggs and 1/8 teaspoon of salt.

Place in 9 inch greased bottom spring-form pan. Add on top, covering entire surface, sliced apples, peaches or plums. In winter, frozen or canned fruit (drained) may be substituted. Sprinkle top of fruit with your choice of cinnamon, sugar or lemon juice. Add a little flour if fruit is very juicy. Bake at 350° F. for one hour (reduce temperature to 325° for Teflon pan).

Serve warm with a dollop of vanilla ice cream or whipped cream. The torte freezes very well, but is best served slightly warm. Refresh in oven.
